Speaking of **responsibility**...

Please take a moment to review this with your child. We refurbish the Chromebooks every summer and we are asking everyone to come together to keep them in good shape. Here is a refresher list of Device Care and Usage for students

- Keep identifying stickers on the device (such as barcode and name tag)
- Limit sticker placement to the red "wearebeechwood" case
- The device **must have a case** (must purchase new case if need be)
- Do not mark, color, or carve anything in or on the device
- Walk with your device lid in the closed position
- Ensure that your device is at a sufficient charge level before school starts (~80%)
- Refrain from eating or drinking over your device
- Damage, loss, or theft must be reported immediately
- Remember that **you are responsible for the care and safety of your device**

Beechwood High School's Gifted and Talented Program currently serves 131 students in grades seven through twelve. These students are formally identified in one or more of these areas:

Beechwood strives to **meet the needs of every learner**, and formal identification in our gifted program can guide our school to:

- Strengthen pathways in student schedules from a younger age, based on areas of giftedness, that will put a plan in place through graduation.
- Bring mentors in to the school based on student interests and goals.
- Provide special counseling services, seminars, or travel study options.
- Be a resource for local, state and national opportunities for gifted students.

A robust **Gifted and Talented Program** is a sign that a school is developing programs with growth for all learners in mind. The student's **Gifted Student Service Plans** are created annually and match a student's interests, needs, and abilities to differentiated service options. Service options include:
