We wanted to make sure you hear this again:

We appreciate your support and patience during the chaos, this response to adversity is what makes our team strong.

Beginning Monday, Feb 15th our school (K-6th) will be at 100% attendance for the first time in a long time which brings several items to the table.

First of all, please understand traffic will be tough and arriving between 7:25-7:40 am is your best bet.

If you arrive after 7:40 the line is beginning to take a little longer, and we could use your help in getting everyone in by our 8:00am start time.

Please pull all the way forward (there is a drop zone marking just past the small black fence in yellow on the ground), and if you are at door #26 or further in the line it is time to drop off your student.

It helps if they have unbuckled in the lot and have backpacks and masks ready to exit quickly.

You should NOT get out of your vehicle at drop off or dismissal as it slows down the line for everyone else.

We will be running a sprint of curriculum and supports for the remainder of the year and have a great plan for every student to keep growing.

Please understand it will continue to be our goal to meet the need of every student in the best way possible.

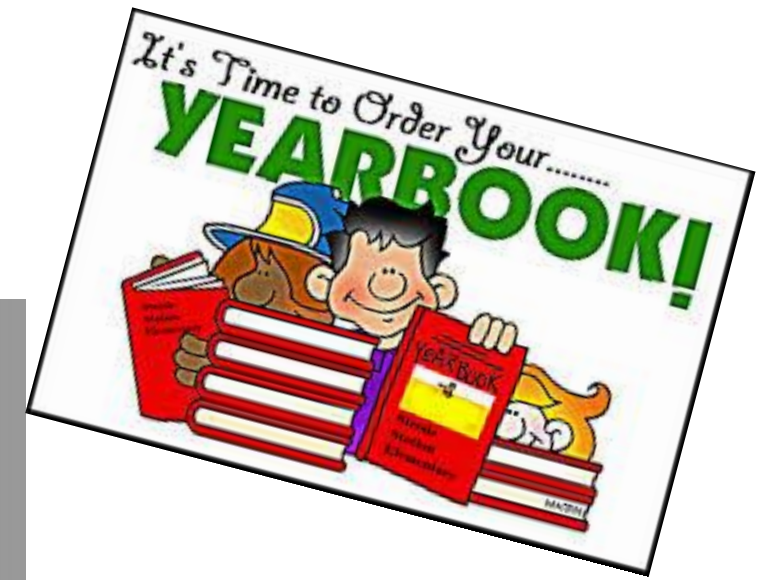

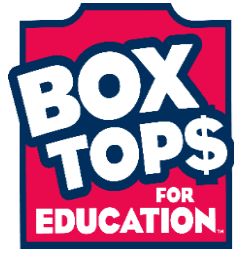

If you are interested, please contact the PTSA at beechwood.ptsa@beechwood.kyschools.us. Make sure you reach out to the PTSA before you begin, so you have all of the guidelines.

- Self Esteem Award (grades preschool through 12th) - deadline 2/10/21
 - Write an essay, story, or poem (not to exceed 500 words) on the theme: "What Makes Me Feel Special". For 6th grade and older, the theme is "Who Am I Inside?"
- Parent PTSA Member \$500 Scholarship Award - deadline 2/10/21
 - The Kentucky PTA will award one \$500 scholarship to a PTSA parent-member planning to attend an accredited public college or university in Kentucky and pursue an undergraduate degree in **education or in a health field**.
