**Attendance Policy:** Our Attendance Policy was revised this year and will impact 2020-21. It was condensed a great deal with the hope of simplifying the procedures and expectations. With Covid-19 and the impact of ever-changing guidelines regarding health and attendance expectations, we will have to again approach this with patience and grace. You can read through the policy on our website which will be updated in July.

**Here are the highlights:**

- \*Pre-Arranged forms are not required for any absence, this information can be communicated with your child's teacher.
- \*In light of absences communicated ahead of time, there will be no work given in advance. ALL 'make-up' work will be given 24-48 hours upon students return to school.
- \*Unexcused absences will result in zeros for 4th-6th grade students
- \*Parent notes will be 7 (same) but more than 3 days should not be taken consecutively
- \*Doctor notes are still the same and will be required to keep absences as excused once 7 parent notes are used
